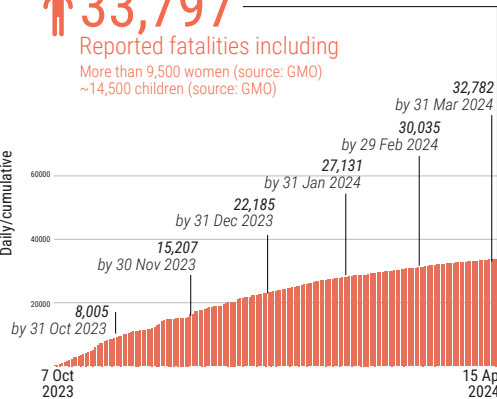

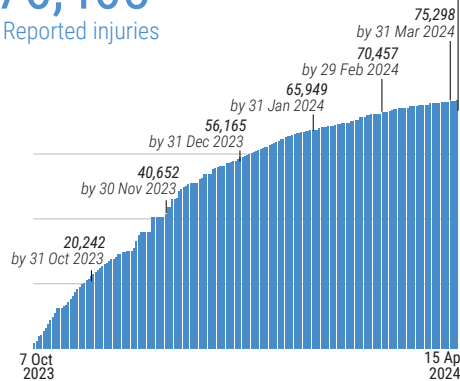

HEALTH

- 11 hospitals partially functioning (5 in north & 6 south of Wadi Gaza).
- 26 hospitals are out of service.
- 6 field hospitals functional, including 4 in Rafah and 2 in Khan Younis.
- ~30% of primary health care facilities functional.
- >640,000 cases of acute respiratory infections (source: WHO).
- >340,000 cases of acute watery diarrhea (source: WHO).
- 20 Emergency Medical Teams (EMTs), including 1 in northern Gaza are operational.
- 33% (8 out of 24) of UNRWA health centers are operational.

FOOD SECURITY*

- 265K people facing crisis levels of food insecurity (IPC Phase 3).
- 854K people facing emergency levels of food insecurity (IPC Phase 4).
- 1.1 million people facing catastrophic levels of food insecurity (IPC Phase 5).
- 60-70% of meat and dairy-producing livestock killed or prematurely slaughtered (source: FAO).

PROTECTION

- ~1.7 million internally displaced persons (IDPs).
- >1 million children in need of mental health and psycho-social support.
- ~17,000 children are unaccompanied or separated.
- At least 244 aid workers killed (238 nationals, 6 foreigners), including:
 - 181 UN staff - UNRWA: 178; WHO: 1; UNDP: 1; UNOPS: 1
 - 27 PRCS staff and volunteers, including 17 while on duty.
 - At least 36 other aid workers.
- 490 health workers killed, including at least 15 also counted under aid workers above (source: MoH Gaza).
- 66 Civil Defence staff killed while on duty (source: GMO).
- 140 journalists and media workers killed (source: GMO).

REPORTED DAMAGE

- >60% of residential buildings (World Bank, as of Jan 2024).
- >80% of commercial facilities (World Bank, as of Jan 2024).
- At least 3 churches and 233 mosques destroyed (source: GMO).
- 155 health facilities (source: MoH Gaza).
- 161 UNRWA installations (source: UNRWA).
- 126 ambulances (source: MoH Gaza).

NUTRITION

- 28 children died of malnutrition & dehydration (source: MoH Gaza).
- ~31% of children under the age of two in northern Gaza suffer from acute malnutrition.
- ~10% of children under the age of two in Rafah suffer from acute malnutrition.
- >50,000 children are estimated to be acutely malnourished at present.

WATER AND SANITATION

- One out of three water pipelines coming from Israel is operational, only at 72% of its full capacity.
- 83% of groundwater wells are not operating.
- All wastewater treatment systems are non-operational; one of them is partially working.
- No access to clean water in the northern governorates.
- Two out of three main water desalination plants are partially functional.
- ~57% of assessed WASH facilities damaged/destroyed.

EDUCATION

- 625,000 students with no access to education.
- >5,800 students and >260 educational staff killed (source: MoE).
- >80% (464 out of 563) of school buildings damaged, including 38% directly hit.
- 59% (188) of school buildings used as IDP shelters have been directly hit or damaged.

SHELTER

- 1 square metre of average space per person in IDP shelters.
- 41% of shelters lack sufficient ventilation.
- 57% of shelters affected by rain and water infiltration.
- 150-155 UNRWA installations shelter IDPs.

INCOMING TRUCKLOADS

The pre-crisis average per working day in 2023 was 500 truckloads, including fuel.
